HM-126 Training for Drivers, HazMat Employees & Security Training

Drivers and HazMat employees are required to have retraining every three years.

Compliance Training

for Owners & Fleet Managers

Seminar will take everyone through a compliance review, such as might be conducted by the Department of Safety. All forms and documents to be in compliance will be provided, such as accident registers, driver qualification forms, sample drug and alcohol policy, etc. The seminar will prepare your company for a compliance review and could save you from a bad safety rating and fines for non-compliance.

You will learn the difference between a compliance review and a safety review. The seminar will include hazardous materials review, record keeping and what is required for a security plan. Attendees will be shown how to access their safety rating information for the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration and what this means.

Each attendee may bring the qualification file on their newest driver and one truck file and the instructor will review and provide a complete list of what should be in every file.

Registration fee includes a Federal Motor Carrier Safety Manual and the instructor will advise attendees on how to use the manual to check for compliance.
